There is no specific FAR that states the doors must be unarmed.

Landing/Arrival/Post-Flight

- Door disarming procedures must be followed as outlined in the Inflight Manual to prevent inadvertent slide deployments.
- FAs responsible for visual cross check must verify that A/C door has been disarmed by telling disarming F/A "Cross checks completed."
