Around 9 pm eastern tonight a PSA Airlines Bombardier CRJ700 regional jet collided in midair with a Sikorsky H-60 helicopter while on approach to Runway 33 at Reagan Washington National Airport around 9 p.m. local time. PSA was operating as Flight 5342 for American Airlines. It departed from Wichita, Kansas. Send all your strength and good thoughts to the crew and first responders while they work a rescue operation in the Potomac
